WHEREAS: The bomb may well explode on us ten, fifteen or twenty year from now in tremendous numbers; and

WHEREAS: Demographic and Health Trends suggest that death from cance may number about eight million annually by the year 2000, according to the World Health Organization report; and

WHEREAS: The United Cancer Institute has proposed a Cancer Control Progration set up mini-cancer detection facilities throughout the Nation to give to those who cannot afford it, a free cancer check up during the week of September 7 through 11, 1980; and

WHEREAS: It is the belief of the medical profession that cancer is curable if detected and treated in its early stages, and that this practice would result in the saving of millions of lives each year;
