WHEREAS: There are over three thousand Naval Reservists residing in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: THE NAVY RESERVE CONTRIBUTES TO THE ECONOMY OF OUR STATE AND THE MILITARY READINESS OF OUR NATION; AND

WHEREAS: MINNESOTA INDUSTRIES CONTINUE TO BE LEADERS IN DEFENSE RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT, AND MANUFACTURING; AND

WHEREAS: THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA RECOGNIZE THE IMPORTANCE OF A STRONG NAVY AND NAVY RESERVE, AND HAVE SHOWN GREAT SUPPORT FOR THESE ORGANIZATIONS; AND

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA HAS BEEN SELECTED TO HOST TO 1980 SUMMER EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING OF THE NAVAL RESERVE ASSOCIATION:

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, AND A FORMER SHIPMATE, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM FRIDAY, JULY 25, 1980 TO BE
