



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: YMCA CAMP IHDUHAPI, IN LORETTO, MINNESOTA, WAS FOUNDED IN 1930;  
AND

WHEREAS: YMCA CAMP IHDUHAPI HAS SERVED OVER 19,000 BOYS AND GIRLS AS  
A SUMMER RESIDENCE CAMP, AND OVER 300,000 MEN AND WOMEN AS  
A YEAR 'ROUND CONFERENCE CENTER; AND

WHEREAS: YMCA CAMP IHDUHAPI IS MARKING 50 YEARS OF CHRISTIAN SERVICE  
TO THE STATE OF MINNESOTA BY CELEBRATING THIS ANNIVERSARY OF  
ITS FOUNDING, AND REDEDICATING THE CAMP TO FUTURE SERVICE TO  
MINNESOTANS; AND

WHEREAS: THE SIOUX WORD "IHDUHAPI" MEANS INDEPENDENCE, AND CAMP IHDUHAPI  
HAS HELPED CAMPERS STRIVE FOR THE GOAL OF INDEPENDENCE IN AN  
ATMOSPHERE OF CHRISTIAN GROWTH AND SHARING; AND

WHEREAS: THE PEOPLE OF MINNESOTA VALUE THE LEADERSHIP WHICH CAMP IHDUHAPI  
HAS PROVIDED TO THIS STATE OVER THE PAST 50 YEARS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA,  
DO HEREBY PROCLAIM AUGUST 2 AND 3, 1980 TO BE

### CAMP IHDUHAPI DAYS

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE  
THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT  
SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF  
JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND  
OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
