WHEREAS: THE United States Coast Guard is celebrating its 190th anniversary ON AUGUST 4. 1980 - THIS DATE ALSO COMMEMORATING ANOTHER YEAR OF OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO OUR CITIZENS ON THE INLAND WATERS OF THE UNITED STATES; AND

WHEREAS: THE United States Coast Guard deserves our recognition for ITS UNTIRING EFFORTS AT EDUCATING CITIZENS IN WATER SAFETY, ASSISTING OUR CITIZENS THROUGH FLOOD RELIEF ACTIVITIES, PROTECTING OUR ENVIRONMENT FROM POLLUTION, AND FULFILLING ITS OTHER HUMAN-ITARIAN MISSIONS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H, QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM AUGUST 4, 1980 TO BE

COAST GUARD DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE ALL CITIZENS TO APPROPRIATELY RECOGNIZE THE 190TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, We have hereunto set our hands and caused the Great SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
