WHEREAS: Common Cause, the citizens' lobby, has, for the past ten years, been an effective voice in advocating greater openness, integrity and responsiveness to the people in our nation's government; and

WHEREAS: For the past year Common Cause in Minnesota has worked conscientiously for similar reforms in Minnesota, including the proposed constitutional amendment which creates the Bipartisan Reapportionment Commission; and

WHEREAS: It is appropriate to recognize the time and effort of Common Cause volunteer activists in achieving these goals: and

WHEREAS: Archibald Cox. National Chairman of Common Cause, will be in Minnesota on September 18 to help celebrate the Tenth Anniversary of Common Cause; and

WHEREAS: The people of Minnesota welcome the efforts of Common Cause, and other groups, to help improve governmental openness, integrity, and accountability;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM SEPTEMBER 18, 1980 TO BE

COMMON CAUSE DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.
