

Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA MASONRY INSTITUTE AND THE MINNESOTA CONCRETE AND MASONRY CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION ARE CONDUCTING THEIR EIGHTH ANNUAL CAMPAIGN TO ENHANCE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE VERSATILITY, ECONOMY AND AESTHETICS OF CONCRETE AND MASONRY PRODUCTS; AND
