



Proclamation

WHEREAS: MAINTAINING THE HEALTH OF THE MINNESOTA WORKER IS A VITAL FUNCTION OF THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSE; AND

WHEREAS: THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSE REPRESENTS THE MAJORITY OF MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS IN PRESERVING THE HEALTH OF EMPLOYEES; AND

WHEREAS: THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSE IS AN ACTIVE PARTICIPANT IN COMMUNITY HEALTH AGENCIES AT THE LOCAL, STATE AND NATIONAL LEVELS; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA ASSOCIATION OF OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSES WAS ORGANIZED THIRTEEN YEARS AGO WITH THIRTY MEMBERS, AND TODAY HAS A MEMBERSHIP OF 236 REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL NURSES; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA ASSOCIATION OF OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSES IS SPONSORING THE REGIONAL OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSING SEMINAR IN COOPERATION WITH CONTINUING NURSE EDUCATION AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA ON OCTOBER 2 AND 3, 1980

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 28 THROUGH OCTOBER 4, 1980 TO BE

OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSE WEEK

IN MINNESOTA AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE ALL CITIZENS TO REFLECT UPON THE VALUABLE CONTRIBUTIONS OF OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH NURSES IN MINNESOTA.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-NINTH DAY OF JULY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
