

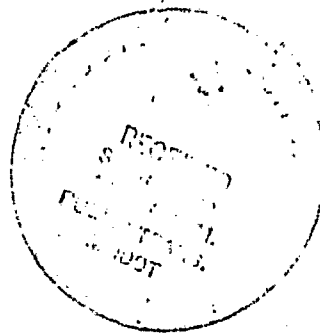

Dear Mr. Carlson:

The Washington Office of the Department of Transportation has asked that I designate an agency in Minnesota to administer the Section 18 program of the Surface Transportation Assistance Act of 1978.

I hereby designate the Minnesota Department of Transportation the administrator and designee of these Section 18 funds. Mn/DOT is a multi-modal transportation agency that has the legal, financial and staffing capabilities to receive and administer federal funds. Mn/DOT has a Public Transportation Division with an Office of Transit Administration that has been financially assisting local transit systems for five years. Mn/DOT through the Transit Office has been the recipient and administrator of Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) Section 9 and Section 16(b)(2) funds. Also, Mn/DOT is the legal recipient of Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funds.

The State of Minnesota is looking forward to working with the Federal DOT in the administration of these new Section 18 funds.


