## A RESOLUTION MODIFYING THE BENEFITS OF ST. LOUIS PARK POLICE RELIEF ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the laws of 1980, Chapter 607, Article 15, allows the City of St. Louis Park to modify any provision of the St. Louis Park Police Relief Association retirement benefits as long as such modification shall not exceed 1.26 percent of covered payroll, and

WHEREAS, the Council, the Board of Directors of the St. Louis Park Police Relief Association and City staff have examined the current plan benefits and have found certain benefit changes to be desireable, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law and sound fiscal management, an actuarial analysis of the proposed changes has been made by the Actuary, Gabriel, Roeder, Smith and Co., and

WHEREAS, this actuarial analysis has shown the actuarial cost of the proposed benefit changes to be 1.23 percent, which is within the allowable cost, and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Louis Park wishes to change certain benefits to recognize the continued years of service given by members of the St. Louis Park Police Relief Association,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the following changes are made in the St. Louis Park Relief Association:

- 1) M.S.A. 423.810(I)(2)(a) is changed to read as follows;"To the spouse a pension of 78 20 units per month,
  - "To the spouse a pension of  $18 \ \underline{20}$  units per month, for his/her natural life, . . .
- Added to M.S.A. 423.809 is <u>subdivision</u> 6, <u>Any member who</u> completes 10 years of service is 100% vested in the plan and is entitled to start drawing upon written application, after retiring from duty, a benefit payable at age 50 of 1/20 times his/her years of service times the benefit at 20 years described in subdivision I(1) above.
- 3) M.S.A. 423.809(I)(2) is changed as follows,". . . but not to exceed 40 42 units."

- 4) M.S.A. 423.801(3) is changed to read, "'unit' means that fractional part of the monthly salary of a first grade patrol officer for the second month of the previous fiscal year as determined in the articles of incorporation of the association which fractional-part-shall-never-be-less-than one-ninetieth-nor-greater-than-one-seventyfifth-of-such monthly-salary is 1/75 of such monthly salary."
- 5) M.S.A. 423.801 (6) is changed to read "'Deferred Pensioner' means a member who has completed not less than 29 10 years of service . . "

This resolution is effective upon filing with the appropriate agencies.
