

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF
THE HONORABLE WALTER F. ROGOSHESKE,
ASSOCIATE JUSTICE OF THE MINNESOTA
SUPREME COURT, FOR RETIREMENT PURSUANT
TO THE PROVISIONS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES
CHAPTER 490.

WHEREAS, the Honorable Walter F. Rogosheske, Associate Justice of the Minnesota Supreme Court, has submitted his written application for retirement by letter dated July 2, 1980, requesting that said retirement be made effective as of September 7, 1980; and

WHEREAS, the said Walter F. Rogosheske has served as an Associate Justice of the Minnesota Supreme Court since February 1, 1962, and had previously served from March 1, 1950 to January 21, 1962 as a District Judge in and for the Seventh Judicial District, State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the said Walter F. Rogosheske was born on July 12, 1914, and has attained the age of 66 years; and


WHEREAS, the said Walter F. Rogosheske has satisfied the necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes Section 490.025, Subdivision 3 for such retirement on September 7, 1980.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Walter F. Rogosheske, Associate Justice of the Minnesota Supreme Court, to become effective on September 7, 1980. He shall become entitled thereafter to retirement compensation as provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Section 490.025. I hereby direct that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
