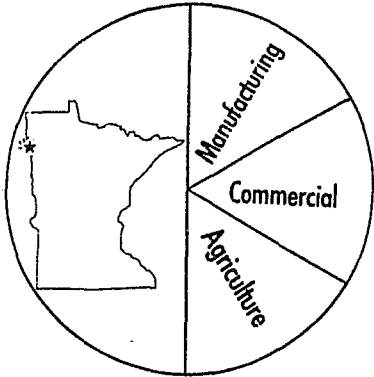

ORDINANCE NO. 171-2ND SERIES

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF EAST GRAND FORKS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS IN SECTION SEVEN (7), TOWNSHIP ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE (151) NORTH, RANGE FORTY-NINE (49) WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, POLK COUNTY, MINNESOTA, NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES, WHICH TRACT CONTAINS 33.72 ACRES.

The City Council of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, does ordain:

Section 1. A Petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota by Park West, Ltd., a North Dakota Corporation; Clifford P. Smart and Irene A. Smart, husband and wife; and First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Crookston, being all of the owners of the land hereinafter described, to have such land included within the City limits of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota; that copies of said Petition were filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Board of Huntsville Township and the County Board of Polk County, Minnesota; that more than 60 days have elapsed since such filings of said petition, and that no objections have been filed as is more fully shown by the records and files herein.

Section 2. That the tract of land being annexed is described as follows, to-wit:

A tract of land in Section Seven (7), Township One Hundred Fifty-One (151) North, Range Forty-Nine (49) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, which tract is described as follows, to-wit:

Section 4. That the City Council hereby determines.

1. That the quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description is less than 200 acres.

2. That the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.

3. That the territory and land described as above abuts upon the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, is suitably conditioned for municipal government and is urban in character.

4. That the Petition for Annexation was signed by all of the owners of the land and real estate hereinabove described.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 2., and the same is hereby annexed to and include in the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the State of Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, the Town Clerk, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

Section 7. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6, and be given the number 171-second series.
