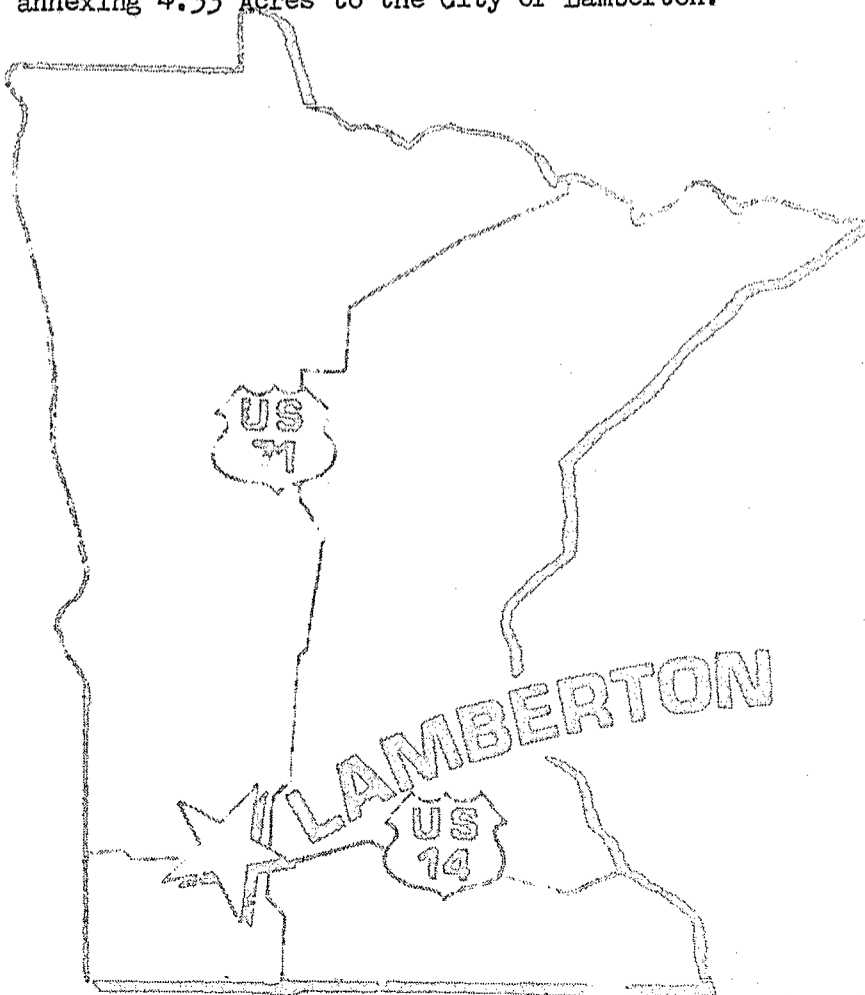

ORDINANCE NO. 117

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAMBERTON TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING ON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS a certain petition dated the 5th day of May, 1980, requesting annexation of the territory described on the enclosed Exhibit A, was duly presented to the Council on the 5th day of May, 1980; and

WHEREAS the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described constitutes approximately 4.33 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of any incorporated city; and

WHEREAS the petition was signed by all of the owners; and

WHEREAS no objections to the annexation has been received from the town board of Lambertton Township in which the property lies, the county, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abutt upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS the land described in the petition abutts upon the City limits on the southerly boundary thereof;

The Council of the City of Lambertton, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be in the best interest of the City and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described upon the attached exhibit A hereto abutts upon the City limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character; (3) that none of said territory is now located within the limits of any city.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described on the

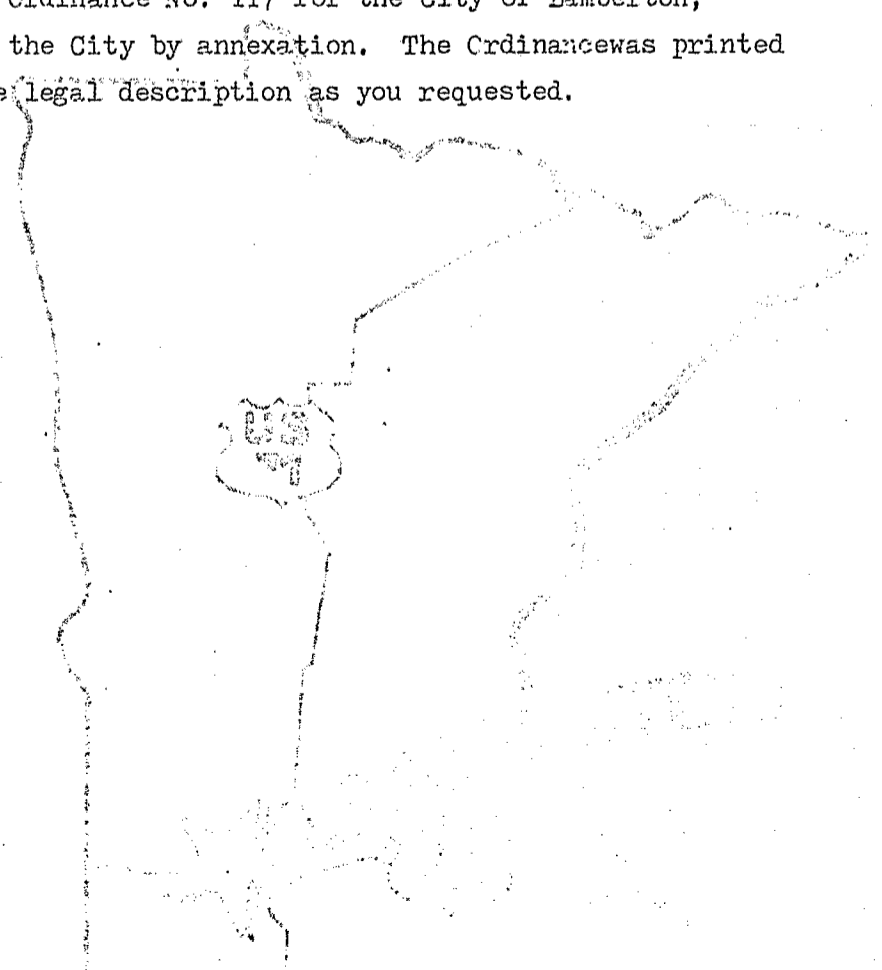

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation has been received from the town board of Lamberton Township in which the property lies, the county, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abutt upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abutts upon the City limits on the southerly boundary thereof;

The City Council of the City of Lamberton, Minnesota, ordains

Section 1: The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be in the best interest of the City and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described upon the attached exhibit A hereto abutts upon the City limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character; (3) that none of said territory is now located within the limits of any city.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described on the attached Exhibit A and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

Section 4. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.

EXHIBIT A

PART TO BE ANNEXED TRACT DESCRIPTION

A tract of land in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, Section 26, Town-

ship 109 North, Range 37 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian. Lamberton Township, Redwood County, Minnesota.

Beginning at a point formed by the intersection of the West line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 26 and the South line of Tenth Avenue in the City of Lamberton, Redwood County, Minnesota; thence East along the said South line of Tenth Avenue a distance of 370.00 feet; thence South parallel with the West line of said Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter a distance of 410.00 feet; thence West parallel with the said South line of Tenth Avenue a distance of 370.00 feet to the West line of said Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter; thence North along said West line a distance of 410.00 feet to the point of beginning and there terminating, containing 4.33 acres subject to easements of record in said County and State.
