



Proclamation

WHEREAS: A WIDE RANGE OF MINORITY ENTERPRISES ARE AVAILABLE TO PROVIDE MANY VALUABLE BUSINESS SERVICES TO CORPORATIONS; AND

WHEREAS: THE SEPTEMBER 15 CORPORATE MINORITY BUSINESS EXCHANGE WILL PROVIDE A MEANS FOR MINORITY FIRMS TO INCREASE PROCUREMENT OPPORTUNITIES WITH MAJOR MINNESOTA CORPORATIONS; AND

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA IS SUPPORTIVE OF PROGRAMS TO EXPAND MINORITY BUSINESS MARKETS WITHIN THE STATE;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM OCTOBER 8, 1980 TO BE

CORPORATE - MINORITY BUSINESS EXCHANGE DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE ALL MINNESOTANS TO OBSERVE THIS DAY WITH AN INCREASED AWARENESS OF COOPERATIVE EFFORTS AMONG MINORITY FIRMS AND OTHER MINNESOTA CORPORATIONS.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TENTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
