



Proclamation

WHEREAS: CYSTIC FIBROSIS IS THE NUMBER ONE GENETIC KILLER OF CHILDREN IN AMERICA, AND BETWEEN ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED ARE BORN EACH YEAR IN THIS COUNTRY WITH THE DISEASE; AND

WHEREAS: PUBLIC UNDERSTANDING OF CYSTIC FIBROSIS IS ESSENTIAL TO ENHANCE EARLY DETECTION AND TREATMENT OF THE DISEASE AND REDUCE THE MISUNDERSTANDING AND CONFUSION CONCERNING THE SYMPTOMS OF CYSTIC FIBROSIS; AND

WHEREAS: A NATIONAL AWARENESS OF THE CYSTIC FIBROSIS PROBLEM WILL STIMULATE INTEREST AND CONCERN LEADING TO INCREASED RESEARCH AND EVENTUALLY A CURE FOR CYSTIC FIBROSIS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 21 THROUGH 27, 1980 TO BE

CYSTIC FIBROSIS WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TENTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
