

Proclamation

WHEREAS: AGRICULTURE IS ONE OF MINNESOTA'S MOST IMPORTANT INDUSTRIES,
AND COMPRISES A MAJOR SEGMENT OF MINNESOTA'S ECONOMY; AND

WHEREAS: FARM FAMILIES HAVE UNITED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ANALYZING THEIR PROBLEMS AND FORMULATING ACTION TO ACHIEVE EDUCATIONAL IMPROVEMENT, ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY AND SOCIAL ADVANCEMENT, THEREBY PROMOTING THE WELL-BEING OF THIS STATE AND NATION; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA FARM BUREAU FEDERATION IS THE STATE'S LARGEST GENERAL FARM ORGANIZATION, AND HAS CONTRIBUTED MUCH TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND THE GROWTH OF MINNESOTA FOR OVER SIXTY YEARS; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA FARM BUREAU FEDERATION IS NOW MAKING PREPARATIONS. FOR ITS 1981 MEMBERSHIP CAMPAIGN:
