

Proclamation

- WHEREAS: NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES WEEK IS A PROJECT OF THE HIGH SCHOOLS OF OUR NATION TO RECOGNIZE STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN AND COMMUNITY SUPPORT OF THE INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITY PROGRAMS IN OUR SCHOOLS; AND
- WHEREAS: IN 1979-80, MORE THAN 388,000 JUNIOR AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS PARTICIPATED IN MINNESOTA SECONDARY SCHOOL ACTIVITY PROGRAMS; AND
- WHEREAS: SCHOOL ACTIVITY PROGRAMS SERVE AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN DEVELOPING MINNESOTA'S FUTURE CITIZENS AND LEADERS; AND
- WHEREAS: SCHOOL ACTIVITIES CAN SERVE AS A FORUM FOR DEVELOPING COMMUNITY PRIDE AND SPIRIT; AND
- WHEREAS: SUCH PARTICIPATION CONTRIBUTES TO THE QUALITY OF LIFE IN THE GREAT STATE OF MINNESOTA;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 28 THROUGH OCTOBER 4, 1980 TO BE

HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I CALL UPON THE CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA TO SHOW SUPPORT FOR THEIR HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES PROGRAMS BY ATTENDING AN EVENT DURING THIS WEEK.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed this tenth day of September IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
