WHEREAS: AMERICAN MENSA IS AN ORGANIZATION DEDICATED TO FOSTERING THE DEVELOPMENT OF HUMAN INTELLIGENCE, SPECIAL EDUCATION FOR THE GIFTED, AND PROVIDING A FORUM FOR THE FREE EXPRESSION OF IDEAS; AND

WHEREAS: IN THIS YEAR, 1980, AMERICAN MENSA IS CELEBRATING ITS TWENTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF SERVICE TO AMERICANS; AND

WHEREAS: THE LOCAL MINNESOTA MENSA IS ACTIVELY INVOLVED IN COMMUNITIES AROUND THE STATE, AS WELL AS NORTH DAKOTA AND SOUTH DAKOTA;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 21 THROUGH 28, 1980 TO BE
