



Proclamation

WHEREAS: WORKING WOMEN CONSTITUTE 33 MILLION OF THE NATION'S WORK FORCE, AND ARE CONSTANTLY STRIVING TO SERVE THEIR COMMUNITIES, THEIR STATES, AND THEIR NATION IN CIVIC AND CULTURAL PROGRAMS; AND

WHEREAS: THE MAJOR GOALS OF BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL WOMEN ARE TO HELP CREATE BETTER CONDITIONS FOR BUSINESS WOMEN THROUGH THE STUDY OF SOCIAL, ECONOMIC, EDUCATIONAL AND POLITICAL PROBLEMS; TO HELP THEM BE OF GREATER SERVICE TO THEIR COMMUNITY; AND TO FURTHER FRIENDSHIPS AMONG WOMEN THROUGHOUT THE WORLD; AND

WHEREAS: MINNESOTANS ARE PROUD OF THE LEADERSHIP WOMEN PROVIDE IN THEIR MANY FIELDS OF ENDEAVOR;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 19 THROUGH 25, 1980 TO BE

NATIONAL BUSINESS WOMEN'S WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME, FURTHER, I URGE ALL CITIZENS TO JOIN IN THIS SALUTE TO WORKING WOMEN.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TENTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
