



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE NEED TO PROVIDE MEANINGFUL OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE YOUTH OF THIS STATE WHICH ENCOURAGE PERSONAL GROWTH, FAMILY AND COMMUNITY INTERACTION, AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF SKILLS FOR PERCEIVING AND FOR RESPONDING TO LIFE'S SIGNIFICANT EVENTS, IS MORE ESSENTIAL TODAY THAN EVER BEFORE; AND

WHEREAS: IT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE 4-H PROGRAM TO MEET THESE NEEDS THROUGH A FOCUS ON HELPING YOUNG PEOPLE ACQUIRE LIFE SKILLS, BETTER ENABLING THEM TO PHYSICALLY, SOCIALLY, AND PSYCHOLOGICALLY RELATE TO THEIR CHANGING ENVIRONMENT BY USING KNOWLEDGE AS A MEANS TO MAKE VALUABLE CONTRIBUTIONS TO MAN AND SOCIETY; AND

WHEREAS: 4-H PROGRAMS INVOLVE OVER 62,000 YOUNG MINNESOTANS FROM BOTH RURAL AND URBAN AREAS OF THIS STATE PARTICIPATING IN OVER 2,500 CLUBS UNDER THE SKILLED LEADERSHIP OF MORE THAN 17,000 ADULT LEADERS; AND

WHEREAS: ALL EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES OF 4-H CLUBS PROVIDE THE OPPORTUNITY FOR THE REALIZATION OF PERSONAL POTENTIAL AND INCREASED UNDERSTANDING OF THE CHALLENGES OF COMMUNITY, STATE AND NATION;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 4 THROUGH 10, 1980 TO BE

NATIONAL 4-H WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE ALL CITIZENS TO OBSERVE THIS WEEK WITH INCREASING AWARENESS AND APPRECIATION FOR 4-H PROGRAMS, AND TO CONTINUE THEIR SUPPORT AND PARTICIPATION IN THEIR MANY FUNCTIONS AND EVENTS.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-EIGHTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
