- WHEREAS: Physical therapists are an important component of the health care delivery system in Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: PHYSICAL THERAPY HELPS RESTORE MOVEMENT AND PHYSICAL INDEPENDENCE IN INDIVIDUALS WHOSE MOBILITY HAS BEEN IMPAIRED; AND
- WHEREAS: Physical therapists are professionals who, after completing college degree programs lasting from four to six years, are tested and licensed by the State Board of Medical Examiners; and
- WHEREAS: THERE ARE MORE THAN 1200 REGISTERED PHYSICAL THERAPISTS AND PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSISTANTS IN MINNESOTA, OVER 750 OF WHOM ARE MEMBERS OF THE MINNESOTA CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSOCIATION; AND

WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSOCIATION IS CELEBRATING ITS SIXTIETH ANNIVERSARY IN THE COMING YEAR:
