



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA IS NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED AS A LEADER IN QUALITY EDUCATION FOR ITS YOUTH; AND

WHEREAS: THERE ARE MANY CHILDREN WHO REQUIRE ONE-TO-ONE ASSISTANCE TO BENEFIT FULLY FROM EDUCATION OFFERED IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND REACH THEIR FULL POTENTIAL; AND

WHEREAS: WISE (WOMEN IN SERVICE TO EDUCATION) AND GISE (GENTLEMEN IN SERVICE TO EDUCATION) IS DEDICATED TO COOPERATION WITH THE MINNEAPOLIS PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO FURTHER THE EFFORTS OF GROUPS AND INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE INTERESTED IN SUPPLYING VOLUNTEER SERVICES TO THE MINNEAPOLIS PUBLIC SCHOOLS; AND

WHEREAS: AN INTENSIVE CAMPAIGN TO INFORM AND RECRUIT VOLUNTEERS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR THIS SPECIAL PROGRAM HAS BEEN PLANNED FOR THIS TIME;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 21 THROUGH 27, 1980 TO BE

WISE AND GISE WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE MINNESTOANS TO SUPPORT AND PARTICIPATE IN THIS WORTHWHILE EFFORT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TENTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY SECOND.
