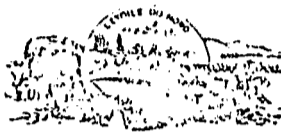

Councilman Karkela moved the passage of the ordinance and it was declared passed upon the following votes:






