ORDINANCE NO. 179

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF LA CRESCENT IN HOUSTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TERRITORY ABUTTING ON SAID CITY PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 414.033, MINNESOTA GENERAL STATUTES, AS AMENDED

The City Council of the City of La Crescent, Houston County, Minnesota, ordains as follows:

WHEREAS, Joseph W. Kistler, Vivian P. Kistler, Charles H. Lehmann, Pamela J. Lehmann, Benjamin P. Lehmann, Sandra Lehmann, Frank Kistler, Julene Kistler, Richard Brostrom, Doreen Brostrom, Leland Schwartzhoff, Carol Schwartzhoff, John Gittens, Gail Gittens, John Graf, Joseph E. Freese, Linda A. Mader, Steven F. Mader, Ronald R. Levendoski, and Marlene Levendoski, being the sole owners of certain real estate hereinafter described, duly petitioned the City Council for the City of La Crescent to have said real estate annexed to and included within said City, and

WHEREAS, said real estate abuts on said City, is not included in any other municipality, is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres in area, and
