

ORDINANCE NO. 14, VILLAGE OF IHLEN, MINN. SOTA.

"Ordinance annexing additional lands to the Village of Ihlen, County of Pipestone, and State of Minnesota."

The Village Council of the Village of Ihlen do ordain as follows:-

Section 1. That the following lands (described as the Southwest quarter (33 $\frac{1}{2}$ %) of the Southeast quarter (33 $\frac{1}{2}$ %) Section No. Nine (9) Township No. one hundred five (105) range No. forty six (46) West of the fifth (5th) P.M. less twenty two and one half (22 $\frac{1}{2}$) acres Railroad ground. Containing Seventeen and one half (17 $\frac{1}{2}$) acres of land abutting upon the incorporated Village of Ihlen. Be and the same are hereby annexed to said Village and shall become a part of such village as effectually as if they had been originally a part thereof.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after certified copies of same have been recorded and filed with the register of deeds, the secretary of state and its publication.
