WHEREAS: SINCE THE BEGINNING OF TIME, SPACE HAS HELD THE INTEREST AND IMAGINATION OF PEOPLE OF ALL LANDS AND CULTURES; AND

WHEREAS: It is important to our life today and to the future of our world that we seek to understand our universe and how this understanding can help us to prepare for the years to come; and

WHEREAS: In recognition of this need for understanding, and in an effort to increase awareness among all citizens, the Minneapolis Public Schools, in cooperation with Futures Systems, is sponsoring a Futures Conference - SPACE: A NEW FRONTIER; and

WHEREAS: During this two day conference, parents, students, educators, and community members will have an opportunity to hear experts discuss the implications of space and its impact on our future;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 19 THROUGH 25, 1980 TO BE
