WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA HOSPITAL, INSTITUTION, AND EDUCATIONAL FOOD SERVICE SOCIETY (H.I.E.F.S.S.) IS A STATE-WIDE SOCIETY OF SKILLED AND CERTIFIED FOOD SERVICE SUPERVISORS; AND

WHEREAS: H.I.E.F.S.S. IS RAPIDLY GROWING AND NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED FOR PROFESSIONALISM; AND

WHEREAS: H.I.E.F.S.S. HAS OVER 12,000 MEMBERS AS LEADERS IN THOUSANDS OF FOOD SERVICE INDUSTRIES;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM NOVEMBER 20, 1980 TO BE

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-FIRST DAY OF OCTOBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
