WHEREAS: THE CITY OF ROTTERDAM IS ONE OF EUROPE'S PRIMARY TRADING AND

COMMERCIAL CITIES; AND

WHEREAS: BURGOMASTER ANDRE A. VAN DER LOUW IS LEADING A DELEGATION OF

DISTINGUISHED CITIZENS OF ROTTERDAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPANDING AND STRENGTHENING COMMERCIAL TIES BETWEEN ROTTERDAM AND THE

STATE OF MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: THE STATE OF MINNESOTA IS HONORED BY THE PRESENCE OF

MAYOR VAN DER LOUW AND HIS DELEGATION IN OUR STATE;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM OCTOBER 23 AND 24, 1980 TO BE

CITY OF ROTTERDAM DAYS

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.
