

## Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE INSURANCE INDUSTRY IN MINNESOTA IS A SIGNIFICANT EMPLOYER OF MINNESOTA RESIDENTS, IS A TAX PAYER PROVIDING STATE FUNDS THROUGH AN EXCESS OF REVENUE OVER EXPENSES, IS AN EXPORTER OF INSURANCE SERVICES TO OTHER PARTS OF THIS COUNTRY AND THE WORLD, AND IS A MAJOR FACTOR IN THE FINANCING OF RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS; AND

WHEREAS: THE INSURANCE INDUSTRY IN MINNESOTA HAS PRODUCED A HIGH DEGREE OF PROFESSIONALISM AMONG ITS MANY AGENTS AND THE INSURANCE COMPANY PERSONNEL THROUGH EDUCATION, ON-THE-JOB TRAINING, AND PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATIONS, INCLUDING THE MINNESOTA CHAPTER OF CHARTERED PROPERTY AND CASUALTY UNDERWRITERS; AND

WHEREAS: This is the 26th All Industry Day Luncheon and Conferment, and the 31st Anniversary of the Minnesota Chapter of Chartered Property and Casualty Underwriters;
