

Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA CHECKERS, HAVING WON THE NATIONAL WOMEN'S HOCKEY CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1980 FOR THE SECOND CONSECUTIVE TIME; AND

WHEREAS: AN International Hockey Series is to be held in Switzerland and West Germany, December 26 through January 4, 1981, with the Minnesota Checkers representing the North American Continent;

AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA CHECKERS HAVE PROVEN THEMSELVES TO BE OUTSTANDING REPRESENTATIVES OF GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP, INTEGRITY, AND ACCOMPLISHMENT;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM DECEMBER 26, 1980 THROUGH JANUARY 4, 1981 TO BE
