- WHEREAS: ONE OF THE MOST TRUSTWORTHY INDICATORS OF THE HEALTH, STRENGTH, AND PROGRESS OF A NATION IS THE ATTITUDE IN WHICH THE FAMILY IS HELD; AND
- WHEREAS: FAMILY STRENGTH, UNITY AND RESPECT CANNOT BE PURCHASED OR FABRICATED, IT COMES TO US INSTEAD WHEN FAMILIES ARE TOGETHER AND REALIZE THAT THROUGH INTERACTION THEY KNOW LOVE, TRUST AND HOPE; AND
- WHEREAS: LIFE IS SPECIAL WHEN WE REALIZE THE WORTH OF THE FAMILY RELATION-SHIP AND ITS IMPORTANCE IN ALL RELATIONSHIPS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 23 THROUGH 29, 1980 TO BE

NATIONAL FAMILY WEEK

IN MINNESOTA AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME, FURTHER, I URGE ALL CITIZENS TO OBSERVE THIS WEEK WITH APPROPRIATE THOUGHTS AND ACTIONS WITHIN THEIR HOMES AND COMMUNITIES.
