



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE VAST MAJORITY OF YOUTH ARE CONCERNED, KNOWLEDGEABLE AND RESPONSIBLE CITIZENS; AND

WHEREAS: THE ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND ACHIEVEMENTS OF THESE YOUNG CITIZENS DESERVE RECOGNITION AND PRAISE FROM THEIR ELDERS; AND

WHEREAS: OPTIMIST INTERNATIONAL HAS SINCE 1957 DEVOTED AND PROMOTED A PROGRAM ENTITLED "YOUTH APPRECIATION WEEK"; AND

WHEREAS: THE CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA HAVE INDICATED A DESIRE TO JOIN WITH THE OPTIMISTS IN EXPRESSING APPRECIATION FOR AND APPROVAL OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF OUR YOUTH;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 9 THROUGH 15, 1980 TO BE

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS SEVENTH DAY OF NOVEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
