DESERVE RECOGNITION AND PRAISE FROM THEIR ELDERS; AND

WHEREAS: OPTIMIST INTERNATIONAL HAS SINCE 1957 DEVOTED AND PROMOTED

A PROGRAM ENTITLE "YOUTH APPRECIATION WEEK"; AND

WHEREAS: THE CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA HAVE INDICATED A DESIRE TO JOIN WITH

THE OPTIMISTS IN EXPRESSING APPRECIATION FOR AND APPROVAL OF

THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF OUR YOUTH;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 9 THROUGH 15, 1980 TO BE
