ORDINANCE NO. 205

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HERON LAKE, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Heron Lake Does Ordain:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Heron Lake, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number of the following described real estate, petitioning to have such land included within the corporate limits of the City of Heron Lake, Minnesota:

All of Lot Seven (7), Benson's Addition in the City of Heron Lake, in the Northwest Quarter, Section 20, Township 104 North, Range 37, West of the 5th P. M. including that tract of land labeled as "road" lying Southerly of said Lot 7 on said Plat as recorded in the office of the County Recorder, Jackson County, Minnesota.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is approximately five acres.

Section 3. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be in the best interest of the City of Heron Lake, Minnesota, and the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City, is urban in character, and is so conditioned as to properly be subjected to City government.

Section 4. The corporate limits of the City of Heron Lake are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Town Clerk of Weimer Township, the County Auditor of Jackson County, Minnesota, and the Secretary of State.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 5.
