



Proclamation

WHEREAS: SINCE 1970, CLOSEUP HAS PROVIDED THE OPPORTUNITY FOR 80,000 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AND TEACHERS TO MAKE WASHINGTON THEIR CLASSROOM; AND

WHEREAS: CLOSEUP INTRODUCES YOUNG PEOPLE FROM EVERY SEGMENT OF LIFE TO THE INTRICACIES OF GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS; AND

WHEREAS: MORE THAN 4,000 STUDENTS AND TEACHERS FROM MINNESOTA HAVE BEEN A PART OF CLOSEUP'S VIGOROUS AND INTENSIVE TRAINING SESSION, MEETING PRESIDENTS, VICE PRESIDENTS, SENATORS, REPRESENTATIVES, LOBBYISTS, DEPARTMENTAL HEADS, AMBASSADORS AND OTHER NEWSMAKERS; AND

WHEREAS: CLOSEUP OF MINNESOTA HAS LONG ENJOYED THE BI-PARTISAN SUPPORT OF OUR KEY MINNESOTA LEADERS, INCLUDING THE LATE SENATOR HUBERT HUMPHREY, THE HONORABLE WALTER MONDALE, THE HONORABLE ALBERT QUIE, SENATOR DAVE DURENBERGER, SENATOR RUDY BOSCHWITZ, AND ESPECIALLY THAT OF CONGRESSMAN BILL FRENZEL; AND
