



Proclamation

WHEREAS: DR. GEORGE WASHINGTON CARVER, THE EMINENT AMERICAN SCIENTIST HAS MADE TREMENDOUS CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE WORLD WHICH WILL EVER LIVE; AND

WHEREAS: BORN A SLAVE, SCHOOLED IN ADVERSITY, AND HONORED IN EMINENCE, DR. CARVER IS A SHINING EXAMPLE OF SERVICE TO HUMANITY - HIS LIFE TYPIFIES THE FACT THAT AMERICA IS JUST ANOTHER NAME FOR OPPORTUNITY; AND

WHEREAS: COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES HAVE SHOWERED HONORS UPON DR. CARVER BECAUSE HIS LIFE IS NOT ONLY AN INSPIRATION TO HIS OWN RACE, BUT TO ALL AMERICANS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM JANUARY 9, 1981 TO BE

GEORGE WASHINGTON CARVER DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE ALL MINNESOTANS TO BE REMINDED ON THIS DAY THAT GOD HAS MADE ALL RACES OF MAN, AND ALL PEOPLE SHOULD TRY TO KEEP THIS GOD-GIVEN BROTHERHOOD.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-FIRST DAY OF NOVEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
