



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS, COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES OF AMERICA SHARE TO SOME DEGREE IN THE CRISIS OF CONFIDENCE AFFECTING ALL SOCIAL INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNITED STATES AND CANADA; AND

WHEREAS: THE FIRST PURPOSE OF PHI DELTA KAPPA INTERNATIONAL IS THE PROMOTION OF HIGH-QUALITY EDUCATION, WITH PARTICULAR EMPHASIS ON PUBLICLY SUPPORTED EDUCATION AS ESSENTIAL TO THE DEVELOPMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF A DEMOCRATIC WAY OF LIFE; AND

WHEREAS: PHI DELTA KAPPA INTERNATIONAL HAS BECOME THE PRE-EMINENT PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION ORGANIZATION IN THE WESTERN WORLD, ENROLLING THE FINEST AND MOST REPRESENTATIVE MEMBERS OF THE PROFESSION AT EVERY LEVEL AND IN EVERY SPECIALTY ON BEHALF OF ITS IDEALS OF RESEARCH, SERVICE AND LEADERSHIP; AND

WHEREAS: PHI DELTA KAPPA INTERNATIONAL WILL, ON JANUARY 1, 1981, BEGIN A YEAR-LONG DIAMOND JUBILEE CELEBRATION OF ITS FOUNDING IN JANUARY 1906, WITH SUITABLE PROGRAMS, PUBLICATIONS AND PROJECTS INVOLVING ITS 116,000 MEMBERS AND ITS 507 CHAPTERS IN THE UNITED STATES AND CANADA;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF JANUARY 1981 TO BE

PHI DELTA KAPPA MONTH

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-FIRST DAY OF NOVEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
