FURTHER, that the Cottage Grove City Council encourages the Metropolitan Council to incorporate the revisions to the Housing Policy 39 Evaluation Criteria into the Housing Chapter of the Metropolitan Development Guide.

Passed this 3rd day of December, 1980.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was duly seconded by Councilman Hamnero. Upon vote being taken thereon, the following voted in favor thereof: Councilman Amundson, Councilman Hamnero, and Acting Mayor Denzer. The following voted against the same: None. Whereupon said resolution was duly declared passed and adopted.

Acting Clerk Lewis presented a status report on the gravel pit owned by Secure Properties, Inc. located in the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 8. Lewis advised the Council that reclamation had progressed but all of the conditions of the temporary 120 day conditional use permit still had not been met.

Mr. Marlin Rygh, owner of the gravel pit, was in attendance and asked that the operator be given more time to comply with the conditions of the 1980 permit. Mr. Rygh also advised the Council that the operator had found material that he wished to excavate in an area that was programmed for reclamation.

Acting Mayor Denzer directed the Planning Department to work with the gravel pit operator and owner to amend the reclamation plan if necessary, and to advise the operator and owner that the temporary conditional use permit has expired and the operator may haul stockpiled material from the site and continue to reclaim areas that are mined, but that no additional mining of new material shall be allowed until the new conditional use permit is approved.


