ORDINANCE NO. 55, SECOND SERIES

ORDINANCE ANNEXING NEUSCHWANDER LANDS TO CITY OF REDWOOD FALLS, MINNESOTA.

THE CITY OF REDWOOD FALLS DOES ORDAIN:

1. That it is hereby found and determined:
 - a. That the lands hereinafter described abut on the City of Redwood Falls.
 - b. That said lands are less than two hundred acres in area and are unplatted, and that a petition for annexation of said lands to the City of Redwood Falls is on file in the office of the Redwood Falls City Administrator and has been signed by all of the owners of said lands.
 - c. That said lands are urban in character.
 - d. That said lands are suitably conditioned for city government.
 - e. That it is for the best interests of the City of Redwood Falls and the owner and residents of said lands that the same be annexed to the City of Redwood Falls.

2. That the following described lands, lying and being in the County of Redwood, State of Minnesota, are hereby annexed to the City of Redwood Falls,

to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section Two (2), Township One Hundred Twelve (112) North, Range Thirty Six (36) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian; thence South 00°43'24" West along the east line of said Section 2 for 547.30 feet; thence North 89°16'36" West for 528.00 feet; thence North 00°43'24" East for 548.77 feet to the north line of said Section 2; thence South 89°07' East along the north line for 514.01 feet to the point of beginning, containing 6.64 acres, more or less. Subject to highway, driveway and utility easements of record.
