

Resolution No. 16776

At a Second Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Crookston.
held the 25th day of November 1980, Alderman J. Sheldon Trandem
offered the following resolution which was seconded by Alderman Bill Thorp

WHEREAS, The Crookston Police Relief Association has requested of the City Council of the City of Crookston approval of amendments of the By-Laws of said association regularly and duly adopted by said association at their meeting of May 14, 1980, by the members of said association; and,

WHEREAS, a copy of said By-Law Amendments is attached hereto and made as much a part hereof as if herein and hereat fully written; and,

WHEREAS, Said Amendments cover Article XV, and

WHEREAS, the normal cost of said benefit plus the amount required to amortize the additional accrued liability created by the adoption of the benefit does not exceed 1.26% of covered payroll, based upon December 31, 1978 actuarial valuation, as required by Minnesota Statute 423A.04 as set forth in the attached actuarial study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the City Council of the City of Crookston that the amended By-Laws of said association in the form hereto attached are hereby in all things approved and upon approval of this resolution said amended By-Laws shall be fully operative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Crookston is authorized and directed to deliver to the Crookston Police Relief Association a certified true copy of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Crookston hereby adopts and approves the Amendment in accordance with Minnesota Statutes Chapter 607, Article XV adopted April 23, 1980, and directs the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Crookston to file a certificate of approval and a copy of this Resolution with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, as directed by Minnesota Statutes 654.021.
