CHAPTER 490.


WHEREAS, the Honorable Searle R. Sandeen, Judge of

County Court Judge in and for the County of Washington for the
past twenty-one (21) years; and

WHEREAS, the said Searle R. Sandeen has satisfied the
necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes
Sections 490.121 to 490.132 for such retirement on January 5, 1981.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, Governor of the State
of Minnesota, acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota
Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement
of the Honorable Searle R. Sandeen, Judge of the County Court,
County of Washington, State of Minnesota, said retirement to be
made effective on January 5, 1981. He shall become entitled
thereafter to such retirement compensation provided under the
provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490. I hereby direct
that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State
of the State of Minnesota.


