The following resolution was offered by Commissioner Robb, seconded by Commissioner Derus:

BE IT RESOLVED, that Hennepin County hereby organizes and establishes the Hennepin County Regional Railroad Authority pursuant to Laws of Minnesota 1980, Ch. 616, the Regional Railroad Authorities Act, as a political subdivision and local government unit of Minnesota to exercise thereunder part of the sovereign power of the state; that the Board of Commissioners of the Authority shall be seven in number and the first Board of Commissioners for the Authority shall be the current members of the Hennepin County Board of Commissioners, namely:
