


IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF
THE HONORABLE HENRY W. LONGFELLOW,
JUDGE OF COUNTY COURT OF THE COUNTY
OF CROW WING, STATE OF MINNESOTA,
FOR RETIREMENT PURSUANT TO THE
PROVISIONS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES
CHAPTER 490.

WHEREAS, the Honorable Henry W. Longfellow, Judge of
the County Court in and for the County of Crow Wing, State of
Minnesota, has submitted his written application for retirement
by letter dated December 19, 1980, requesting that said retirement
be made effective on January 5, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the said Henry W. Longfellow has served as
Probate and County Court Judge in and for the County of Crow Wing
for the past twenty-four (24) years; and

WHEREAS, the said Henry W. Longfellow has satisfied the
necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes
Section 490.121 to 490.132 for such retirement on January 5, 1981.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, Governor of the State
of Minnesota, acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota
Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement
of the Honorable Henry W. Longfellow, Judge of the County Court,
County of Crow Wing, State of Minnesota, said retirement to be
made effective on January 5, 1981. He shall become entitled
thereafter to such retirement compensation as provided under the
provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490. I hereby direct
that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State
of the State of Minnesota.
