RESOLUTION

Moorhead, upon recommendation of the Finance and Administration Committee and the Public Safety Committee, that an alternative benefit increase of \$1,080 per year be permitted those persons who have retired since the enactment of Laws of 1980, Chapter 607, Article XV, Section 7 (Minnesota Statutes \$423A.04) or who will be retiring in the future after twenty (20) years of service and who are covered by the retirement benefits of the Moorhead Police Relief Association, said increases being in lieu of an increase of one-half of one percent after twenty-five (25) years of service and being considered a health and welfare benefit to defray part of the cost of health insurance and doctor care.

Dear Mr. Warren:

We have evaluated the alternative benefit increases as requested in connection with the recent state legislation to phase out local police and firemen's relief associations in Minnesota.

Our computations are based upon the provisions of the retirement system, the actuarial assumptions and the actuarial methods contained in the actuarial valuation as of December 31, 1978.

The financial results are shown in the exhibit attached. The minimum obligation of the City before reductions for member contributions and state aid are shown.

The retirement program may be revised as follows without exceeding the maximum increase in the contribution as a percent of payroll of 1.26%.

- Additional 2.75% An additional benefit may be provided to future age and service retirants of 2.75% of final average pay after 20 years of service.
- 2. Additional \$1,080 An additional benefit may be provided to future age and service retirants of \$1,080 (irregardless of pay) after 20 years of service.
