
Dear Ms. Lundy:

ORDINANCE NO. 264  
CITY OF ADRIAN  
NOBLES COUNTY, MINNESOTA

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING  
TERRITORY TO THE  
CITY OF ADRIAN

WHEREAS, The tract of land hereinafter described is unplatted, abuts on the City of Adrian, and is not included in any other municipality;

AND WHEREAS, All owners of such tract hereinafter described have heretofore petitioned the City Council to have such land included within the City of Adrian,

AND WHEREAS, The City Council finds and determines that the annexation of the above property will be in the best interests of the public, of the City of Adrian and of said territory,

AND WHEREAS, The annexation of such territory under the above circumstances is authorized by Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.033, Subd. 5;

AND WHEREAS, The Township of Olney, Nobles County, Minnesota, has consented to the annexation and waived public hearing and any waiting period;

AND WHEREAS, All required filings with public bodies have been effected and that no public hearing with respect to annexation is required by law.

AND WHEREAS, The following described 2 tracts of land are abutting tracts and are contiguous to the city limits of the City of Adrian:

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Adrian as follows:

SECTION 1: The following described land is hereby annexed to the City of Adrian:

TRACT 1: That part of the West Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 102, North, of Range 42, West of the 5th P.M., Nobles County, Minnesota, lying south of the center line of Nobles County Road No. 35 (old Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 16) and north of the right-of-way of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway Company.

TRACT 2: That part of the East Half of the Northeast Quarter and the East Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 102, North, of Range 42, West of the 5th P.M., Nobles County, Minnesota, lying southerly of the right-of-way of Interstate Highway No. 90 and lying northerly of right-of-way of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway Company, subject to easement for highway purposes.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication, and upon filing a copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Auditor of Nobles County, The Minnesota Secretary of State and the Town Clerk of Olney Township, Nobles County, Minnesota.


