WHEREAS: CEREBRAL PALSY IS THE MOST WIDESPREAD AND LIFELONG DISABILITY IN THE NATION; AND

WHEREAS: CEREBRAL PALSY AFFECTS THE LIVES OF 13,000 MINNESOTANS; AND

WHEREAS: THE CONDITION OF CEREBRAL PALSY CAN RESTRICT MOBILITY, DEXTERITY, AND COMMUNICATION ABILITY; AND

WHEREAS: UNITED CEREBRAL PALSY OF MINNESOTA, AND ITS AFFILIATES, IS THE ONLY AGENCY SPECIFICALLY DEDICATED TO IMPROVING THE LIVES OF INDIVIDUALS AFFECTED BY THIS CONDITION; AND

WHEREAS: UNITED CEREBRAL PALSY OF MINNESOTA, AND ITS AFFILIATES, CONTINUALLY STRIVE TO IMPROVE AND EXPAND PROGRAMS OF THERAPY, REHABILITATION, RESEARCH AND LIFE OPPORTUNITIES; AND

WHEREAS: UNITED CEREBRAL PALSY OF MINNESOTA AND ITS AFFILIATES RECOGNIZE THE NEED TO DEVELOP COMMUNITY AWARENESS OF THE CONDITION AND TO SEEK COMMUNITY SUPPORT;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM JANUARY 17 AND 18, 1981 TO BE

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS SIXTEENTH DAY OF JANUARY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY ONE, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SECOND.
