- WHEREAS: THE UNITED NATIONS HAS PROCLAIMED 1981 AS THE INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF DISABLED PERSONS; AND
- WHEREAS: COURAGE CENTER PROGRAMS ANNUALLY SERVE MORE THAN 15,000 PEOPLE WITH PHYSICAL DISABILITIES AND SPEECH, HEARING AND VISION DISORDERS; AND
- IT IS APPROPRIATE TO SET ASIDE A DAY IN 1981 TO RECOGNIZE WHEREAS: THE CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY COURAGE CENTER TO THE COMMUNITY;
