WHEREAS: THE ENVIRONMENT, AGRIBUSINESS, RESOURCES, TECHNOLOGIES AND HORTICULTURE ASSOCIATION OF MINNESOTA (EARTH) IS A STATEWIDE ORGANIZATION DEDICATED TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF EACH STUDENT'S SOCIAL AND LEADERSHIP ABILITIES AND SKILLS; AND

WHEREAS: There is a definite need for further eudcation in agriculture and agriculture related fields to insure the future development of its people and economic growth; and

WHEREAS: EARTH IS MAKING CONTINUOUS CONTRIBUTIONS FOR ADVANCEMENT OF EDUCATION IN AGRICULTURE AND AGRICULTURE RELATED FIELDS TO INSURE THE FURTHER DEVELOPMENT OF PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL GROWTH; AND

WHEREAS: EARTH'S MAIN OBJECTIVES ARE TO PROVIDE OCCUPATIONAL EXPERIENCE PROGRAMS IN ALL PHASES OF THE AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY, TO EMPHASIZE THE DEVELOPMENT OF LEADERSHIP, CITIZENSHIP, PERSONAL IMPROVEMENT AND OCCUPATIONAL RESPONSIBILITY; AND
