

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Diseases of the Heart and Blood Vessels are Responsible for More Deaths in Minnesota than all other causes combined, causing Widespread Suffering, and often creating serious economic Hardship in our homes and Businesses; and

WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION, MINNESOTA AFFILIATE, CARRIES FORWARD A RELENTLESS FIGHT AGAINST THESE DISEASES THROUGH ITS PROGRAMS OF RESEARCH, PUBLIC AND PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICE, AS MADE POSSIBLE BY PRIVATE CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE HEART FUND; AND

WHEREAS: In RECOGNITION OF THE NECESSITY OF CONSTANT VIGILANCE AGAINST THE RAVAGES OF CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE AND TO ENCOURAGE STILL GREATER EFFORTS TO COMBAT ITS THREAT TO ALL MINNESOTANS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY 1981 TO BE

HEART MONTH
