WHEREAS: Home economics is a profession founded in research and education, primarily concerned with strengthening family life; and

WHEREAS: Home economists are active in business, education, communications, research, public policy legislation and community development; and

WHEREAS: Through professional knowledge and skills, home economists improve the living standards and the quality of family and community life; and

WHEREAS: THE AMERICAN HOME ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION, AN EDUCATIONAL AND SCIENTIFIC ORGANIZATION FOUNDED IN 1909, IS AMONG THE 20 LARGEST PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATIONS IN THE UNITED STATES WITH A MEMBERSHIP OF MORE THAN 30,000 MEN AND WOMEN; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA HOME ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION, ONE OF 52 AFFILIATES OF A.H.E.A. HAS A MEMBERSHIP OF 1,200; AND

WHEREAS: Home economists influence the future of families through programs which focus on public policy, consumer interests, energy conservation, and strengthening family life;
