



Proclamation

WHEREAS: ON DECEMBER 10, 1948 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS ADOPTED AND PROCLAIMED THE UNIVERSAL DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS; AND

WHEREAS: THIS DOCUMENT RECOGNIZES THE INHERENT DIGNITY AND THE EQUAL AND INALIENABLE RIGHTS OF ALL HUMAN BEINGS, AND HAS SET A COMMON AND UNIVERSALLY ACCEPTED STANDARD OF HUMAN RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS FOR ALL PEOPLES; AND

WHEREAS: DECEMBER 10, 1980 MARKS THE 32ND ANNIVERSARY OF THE ADOPTION OF THE UNIVERSAL DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM DECEMBER 10, 1980 TO BE
